



GRADUATE PROGRAMME IN PUBLIC HEALTH 2019

The Discipline of Public Health Medicine is calling for Applications from Prospective students for the 2019 intake into the Graduate Programme of Public Health. The Graduate Programme in Public Health aims to produce health professionals who are change agents in the field of Public Health. The Programme offers a **Postgraduate Diploma in Public Health** (4 semesters coursework) and a **Master of Public Health** [6 semesters course-work (50%) and 2 semesters research (50%)].

Eligibility Criteria

- ❖ **Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health:** A minimum of 3-year Bachelor's degree in a health or social science related discipline with a minimum of 1-year programme or clinical research or clinical experience in the health or social sector (post community service).
- ❖ **Master of Public Health:** A minimum 4-year Bachelor's degree at an honour's level or a 3-year degree plus a postgraduate diploma or honour's degree in a health related or social science discipline, or any health related domain. This must be accompanied by a minimum of 1-year programme or clinical research or clinical experience in the health or social sector (post community service).

Please Note: the Primary Undergraduate Degree must be a Bachelor's degree and not a 4 year National Diploma or Advanced Diploma or a Postgraduate Diploma without a primary degree. Please note that a B.Tech degree does not fulfil the requirements for a Master's degree on its own.

Structure of Programme: The curriculum is fully modularized, with core and elective modules. This is offered on a part-time basis, with each module requiring face-to-face contact over the semester.
